MSU LIFE Scholars Pilot Program Details

Mission: To provide students with intellectual and developmental disabilities a fully inclusive post-secondary experience.

Eligibility: Desire to attend college, identified as an individual with ID, 18+ years

Length of Program: 2 - 4 years (last year Project SEARCH internships)

Number of students: 4-6

Courses: 1-3 courses / semester for audit or credit

Certificate: Awarded upon completion of program

Funding: Combination private pay, scholarships, VR / DD (?)

Program launch date: Fall 2018

Program Learning Outcomes

Students will:

- **Become lifelong learners.**
- **Develop self-determination** to achieve individual life goals.
- **Gain knowledge** by enrolling in courses that interest them.
- **Explore careers** by completing a variety of internships.
- **Expand social networks** and develop authentic peer relationships.
- **Be actively engaged** in the campus community through involvement in extracurricular activities, joining clubs, and contributing to service organizations.
- **Earn a LIFE Scholars certificate** by completing all program requirements.
- **Obtain meaningful, competitive employment upon graduation.**
